## NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

### for the Truro and Kenwyn Neighbourhood Plan

1. A Referendum will be held on **Thursday, 27th April 2023** to decide the question:

**“Do you want Cornwall Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Truro and Kenwyn to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”**

2. Applications to register to vote or to vote by post or proxy should be made to the Electoral Registration Officer at 4th Floor, South Wing, County Hall, Treyew Road, Truro, TR1 3AY based on the deadlines set out below:

New applications to vote by post or to cancel or amend an existing postal/proxy vote	5 pm on Wednesday, 12th April 2023
New applications to vote by proxy	5 pm on Wednesday, 19th April 2023
Applications for an emergency proxy vote (in cases where unforeseen illness, incapacity, occupation, service or employment occurs after the deadline for proxy applications).  The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 19th April 2023.  To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 19th April 2023.	5 pm on Thursday, 27th April 2023
