MINUTES FOR FULL COUNCIL MEETING OF KENWYN PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT SHORTLANESEND METHODIST CHURCH ON MONDAY 10TH JULY AT 7:41PM

2074/2023 - TO RECEIVE AND APPROVE APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Cllrs Robinson, La Borde & Penhallurick

2075/2023TO RECEIVE ANY DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST FROM MEMBERS AND GIFTS OF HOSPITALITY IN EXCESS OF £50

2077/2023 - CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

The climbing frame at Threemilestone has been fixed after being overloaded and one of the bolts holding the bottom step gave way.

The posts preventing people driving onto the field at Shortlanesend are rotting and will be replaced soon.

2078/2023 - Questions from Parishioners (10 minutes maximum, 3 minutes per parishioner)

None we received but Cllr Dyer enquired how we were going about advertising the vacancies. Cllr Dyer was advised that this is now a rolling item on the agenda and that the vacancies are being advertised in the usual manner, namely on our Social Media, Website and on our noticeboards throughout the parish.

2079/2023 - To approve the minutes of previous meetings

Minutes for the planning committee meeting held on 12th June 2023 were approved and signed

Vote - 6 in favor with 2 abstentions as members were not present

Minutes for the full council meeting held on 12th June 2023 were approved and signed

Seconded by - Cllr Jones

Vote - 6 in favor with 2 abstentions as members were not present

2080/2023 - Finance and Payment of Accounts

Observations – The accounts were checked by Cllr Green and Cllr Gammon and were recommended for payment

Vote - Unanimous

2081/2023 - Reports from Meetings

Cllr Green advised that he had attended the Police Liaison Group and it was well attended by councilors from various parishes. Cllr Green further advised that anti-social behavior at Threemilestone was raised and discussed and the police are aware of the situation and seeking a solution

Cllr Jones advised that he had attend the Threemilestone Community Centre Committee meeting and there have been a couple of cases of arson in the public toilets on the exterior of the building

2082/2023 - To consider paying a voluntary contribution for venue hire at Threemilestone

Community Centre

It was proposed that we pay commercial rates for the hire of the venue for our bi-monthly meetings and the acting Clerk would liaise with the community centre.

Proposed – Cllr Gammon

Seconded – Cllr Holroyd

Vote – 5 in favor, 2 against and 1 abstention

2083/2023 - To consider purchasing and installing a litter bin outside of the bus stop at Shortlanesend

The acting clerk was asked to obtain a price for the installation and to contact highways to decide on an appropriate location

2084/2023 - To discuss footpath/pavement between school entrance and playing field at Shortlanesend

Members thought this was a good idea and asked that highways, Cllr David Harris and Cllr La Borde be contacted about this to raise at the Truro & Roseland Community Area Partnership meeting

2085/2023 - To consider applications received at the time of the meeting for two vacancies on Kenwyn Parish Council.

None were received

2086/2023 - To discuss footpath in park at Chyvelah Ope

The acting Clerk was asked to obtain quotes and suggestions on appropriate flooring from play equipment companies and also to attempt contact with sanctuary housing once more to discuss footpath approaching the park from the car par

2087/2023 - To Discuss noticeboard at Threemilestone Community Centre

It was decided to once again liaise with the Chairman of TMSCC to discuss either another location or having the noticeboard installed by them and reimbursed by us.

2088/2023 - To discuss engaging schools and churches etc. in serenity gardens and other

areas of the parks - Cllr Gammon

Members approved of this idea and it was suggested that a small contingent of members attend the schools and discuss and this will be added to an agenda in the autumn to discuss further

2089/2023 - To update members on Friends of Threemilestone Park and Friends of Shortlanesend Village Hall and Park and to co-opt new members

Cllr Hazell joined the Friends of Threemilestone Group and it was agreed that this would be discussed again in September to go with item 2089/2023 and to discuss a project budget for these groups

2090/2023 - Confirmation of no conflict of interest with BDO (external auditor)

This was agreed by members that Kenwyn Parish Council has not conflict of interest with BDO – Proposed by Cllr Green, Seconded by Cllr Holroyd and the vote was unanimous.

2091/2023 - Items for the next agenda

Item 2090/2023 were added to our next agenda

Item to agree a newspaper advert for both co-option of new members and for Friends of groups.
